1. Your Session and Zoom Link

Zoom Link for Session Chairs

- Zoom link for session chairs is shared via email. Please do not share this Zoom link with other participants since it is as reserved only for session chairs, speakers, and organizers.
- To ensure the smooth management of sessions, Zoom test will be held during the long break times. It is recommended that you access Zoom and check the conditions at that time. Please check the Zoom test timetable for each session which is provided further down. If you are not available for the Zoom test, please enter your session via Zoom in advance. The stand-by must be completed 30 minutes before the session time. Please let us know if any difficulty comes from the Zoom test. We will conduct a simple test during this period.
- When you enter Zoom, please change your user name to <session name_Last name>. e.g.) S1_Pauli

2. Zoom Meeting

We will create two Zoom rooms to deliver the talks to ensure a smooth operation. The first room is to host speakers, session chairs, and organizers while the second room is to host participants watching the sessions.

During talks, **please press the mute button to prevent unexpected sound dispatch.** (Please note that our staff could mute your microphone whenever it's necessary).

3. Zoom Test

Please connect to the Zoom link with a PC or laptop in an environment with good network connections.


Below are the checklists for the session:


- If possible, please **use headsets** when chairing sessions to improve audio quality.
- Turn off your phone ringer and/or any audible email reminders.
- Please mute while waiting for your turn to speak.
- Please do not connect to the ZEP Metaverse and Live Session Room on the website during your session. The audio may overlap.

After the Zoom test, please mute the microphone until you need to speak. Please turn it on when you can see your face on the streaming screen. For more details, please check the following.

4. During the Session

First of all, when you enter Zoom, you can see the other participants' mini-screens at the top. Left cartoon below shows your screen before someone else's screen is shared, and when the screen is shared, the top mini-screens move to the right side (Right cartoon below).





If you click the 'Streaming Screen', you can see the way it is being broadcast to the participants.

1. Session Beginning

Until the session starts, you can view the session promotional slides as shown in the left image below. When the session starts, you will see your face in the upper left of the screen as shown in the right image below. Please shortly introduce yourself and briefly explain the session.



2. Speaker Introduction and Presentation Start

After the session introduction, please proceed with a speaker introduction. When the speaker is introduced, you can see the speaker's face like the left image below. After introduction of the speaker, the speaker will start the presentation right away. **During the talk, questions will be sent to you by direct message. Please check the direct messages carefully.**



3. Q&A Session

After a talk ends, the Q&A session will proceed. Please select some of the questions delivered to you and ask the speaker. Please note that you must check the Q&A time in the detailed program in advance to make sure there is no overtime.
